To start with Year 6 will find out what is nature's impact on the world, specifically looking at natural disasters. Next they will go on to find out about what the human impact on the world is, including energy consumption and reusing materials. Finally Year 6 will learn how they can impact tomorrow's world. Their final outcome will be to put on an exhibition highlighting the importance of tomorrow's world.

Other Curriculum Areas...

In Science we will we will recognise that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the earth millions of years ago. We will also identify how adaptation of animals and plants over time may lead to evolution.
